

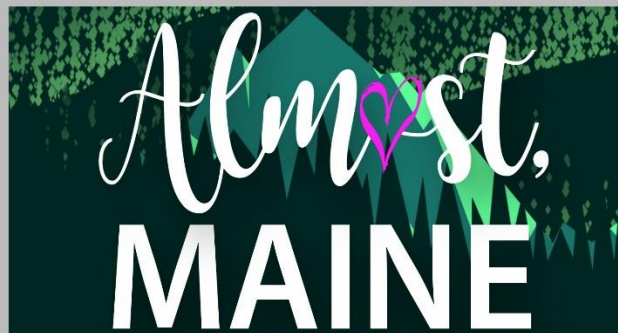

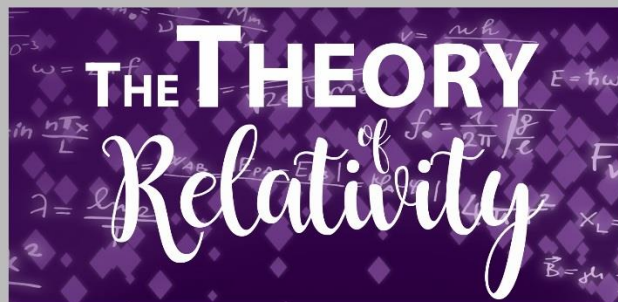

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Welcome to our 6th annual OPENING NIGHT showcase & STAGE fundraiser! Five years ago, we set out to add even more opportunities to Tiger Drama. Recognizing the lasting value for students to participate in extra-curricular activities like theatre and providing a place where they can explore were just two of the many reasons for the concept of OPENING NIGHT. Students, on their own, choose and prepare their pieces for our auditions. At that point, we meet as a production team to determine order, theme and sometimes make adjustments on the pieces that are auditioned. Rehearsals take place for two short weeks where students learn to work as an ensemble, learn the basics of participating in a production and experience a condensed version of a full production rehearsal process.

The format of our first OPENING NIGHT was a happy accident and it highlighted how the creativity, talent and imagination of so many individuals can come together to create a cohesive evening of storytelling in a way that features so many dedicated LC Tiger Drama students. Another “happy accident” was the inspiration for students to be researching and rehearsing all year long for what might be a good selection for them/their classmates. OPENING NIGHT provides a great vehicle for students to explore potential IE pieces as well as audition and class performance pieces.
